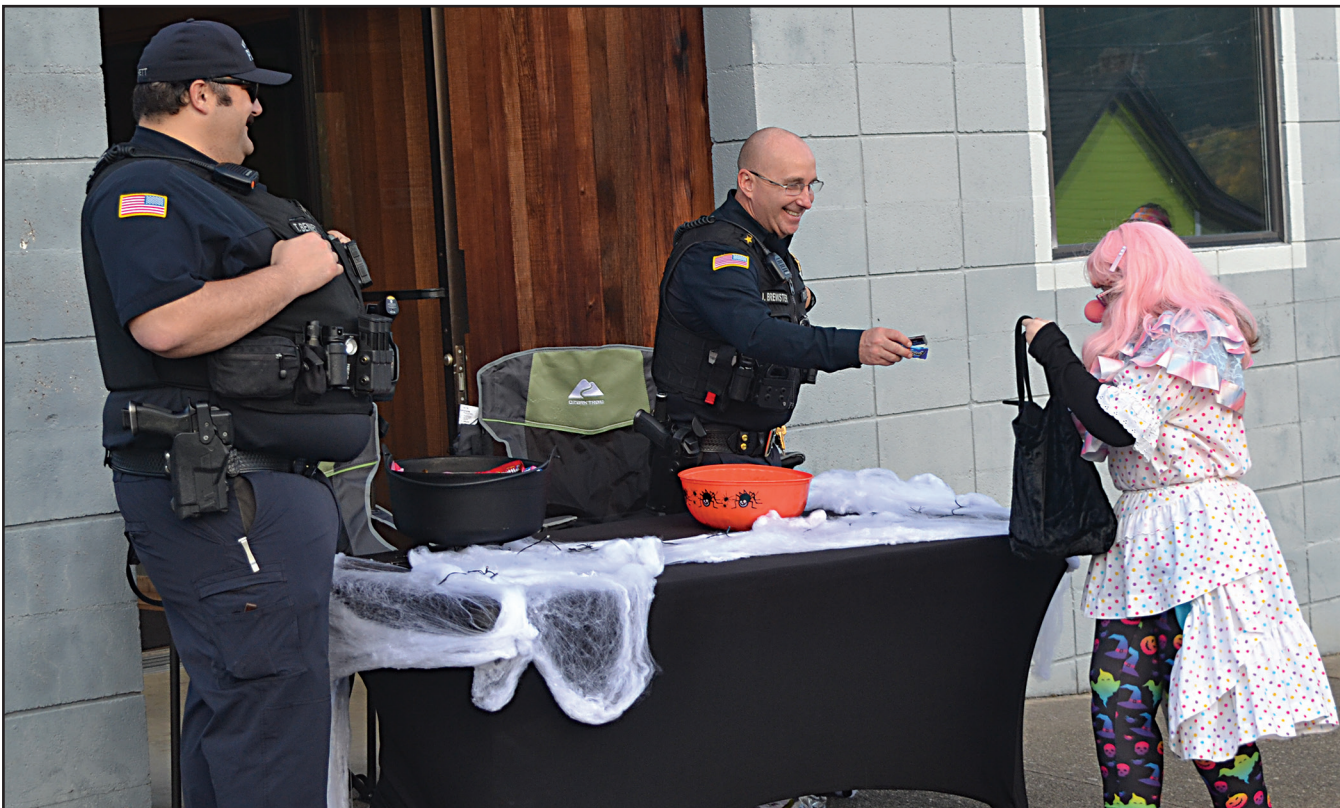
Student learning is always a top priority. Recent reading data

Plus, good attendance also plays a big role in student achievement. Going to school every day helps students build strong habits, form friendships and prepare for their future.

## Riddle capsizes Glendale to make playoffs

RIDDLE – In the final game of the regular season the riddle football team rose to the occasion and took care of the visiting Glendale Pirates 40-20 to secure a spot in the O.S.A.A. 1A eight man playoffs, their first playoff berth since 1995.

It didn’t hurt that this was also the Irish’s Homecoming game and held on Friday, October 31, Halloween no less. Also adding fuel to the fire was that someone had decided to paint the usually white big R, red.

Riddle came out firing early and took a 6-0 lead on a 54 yard gallop by Isaiah Ibrahim and maintained that lead throughout the first quarter. They built that lead to 12-0 in the second when quarterback Layton Rainwater hit Stephen Nordyke on a six yard strike.

Glendale was not to be outdone and the rest of the second quarter belonged to the Pirates as they built a 14-12 lead at the half.

A halftime speech by Ibrahim about just going out and having fun seemed to motivate the Irish as they came out charged up and took the lead back for good in the thirds with another rushing touchdown by Ibrahim, this one from 21 yards out. The conversion failed bu Riddle had the lead 18-14.

In the fourth the Irish

pushed the lead out even more as Ibrahim found the end zone for the third time on the night, this time from 10 yards away. The conversion was good and Riddle led 26-14.

With about five minutes left in the game Glendale cashed in on a 56 yard pass to cut the deficit to 26-20.

On their next possession the Irish took care of business as Jonathan Harp burst through the middle and 44 yards later was in the end zone for another score and with successful conversion Riddle led by 14, 34-20.

Harp capped off the night on Glendale’s ensuing possession as he intercepted a Rocha pass and took it 51 yards to the house with no time left on the clock for the game ending pick six giving the Irish a 40-20 victory.

The Irish defense stood strong in the second half only allowing just 25 yards over the two quarters not counting the 56 yard scoring play.

Riddle Head Coach Jason Luft praised his defense for their second half play. He also noted that the return of Austin Dean in the second half sparked the team. Dean sat out the first half due to injury.

The Irish now face the sixth-ranked and seeded Imber Panthers on Saturday, November 8. Kickoff is set for 2 p.m.

## Check email for boat registration renewals

SALEM – The Oregon State Marine Board will be emailing motorboat registration renewal notices to boaters who have email addresses on file whose registration expires on December 31, 2025. Each renewal notice is unique to the owner and their boat. Owners are encouraged to take advantage of the online renewal option, and the email has detailed instructions for using the Boat Oregon Store. For boaters who do not have an email address on file with the agency, renewal notices will be sent via US Mail and should arrive by mid-November.

The fastest way to get on the water is to renew online through the Marine Board’s Boat Oregon Store, which provides a printable temporary permit to go boating right away. Owners can renew multiple boats or pur-

chase Waterway Access Permits in one transaction for a \$1.50 portal provider fee. The registration decals are mailed within 2-5 days from online sales and within 7-10 business days from the date of receipt by US mail with payment and the remittance coupon. Owners can then expect an additional 2-4 weeks for their decals to arrive by US Mail. The timelines may vary since printing and mailing are handled outside the agency.

Any watercraft with a motor or sailboats 12 feet or longer are required to be titled and registered with the Marine Board. Early bird online sales begin on November 1. Motorboat registration fees are \$8 plus \$5.95 per foot and are issued on a 2-year calendar basis for 2026. Renewing in the fall or early winter months is recommended to avoid long delays during the

peak summer season.

Nonmotorized boaters of kayaks, canoes, rafts, drift, stand up paddleboards, and their inflatable versions can also purchase waterway access permits through the Boat Oregon Store. A 7-day permit costs \$6, an annual permit is \$20, and a two-year permit is \$35. Annual and two-year permits are also valid for one or two calendar years. Paddlers are encouraged to purchase permits early in the year to get the most use out of them and to explore the bounty of waterways in the state. Because permits can be saved or printed immediately, they make great “stocking stuffers” for the holidays, especially if you plan on gifting someone a boat. Permits are transferable to other paddlecrafter, and children under 14 are exempt.

ly release Wednesdays and in-service days.

In early October, two in-service days provided all employees with meaningful training opportunities. The first day was held at Tri City Elementary where everyone came together to learn strategies that support students. Offbeat Oregon History

# The all-night municipal gunfight of the frontier town of Ione

Plenty of Oregon towns have been the scene of Old West-style gunfights during the frontier era, but very few of them have ever hosted one in which nearly everybody in the town participated.

The tiny town of Ione, in northern central Oregon, is one that has.

The occasion of Ione’s experiment in mixing a gunfight with a block party (“two great tastes that taste great together”?) was the arrival on the scene of a local troublemaker named Charles Earhart.

Earhart was well known to the citizens of Ione. At various times a wheat farmer and a saloonkeeper, he was also an ex-convict, having just been pardoned out of the joint six months earlier on charges stemming from a drunken shooting spree in Ione. He was one of those fellows who’s perfectly nice until he takes a drink — but after that, watch out.

That night, his boilers were well stoked — and he was on the town to settle a score. Before his jail stretch, when he was keeping his saloon in town, he’d boarded with a woman named Mary Granger. He and Mrs. Granger apparently got along too well for the tastes of her husband. Whether there was anything to be jealous of or not is unknown, but Mr. Granger was confident enough in his conclusions that he moved out, taking the couple’s two sons with him and leaving three daughters — ages 10, 13 and 14 — with her. The couple had a fourth daughter as well, who had married a man named Henry Clark and left the nest.

Months went by. Earhart went to prison, served a year and a half, was pardoned by the governor, and moved back to town. Mary Granger left her boardinghouse business and took a job as manager of the Ione Hotel. And then, in late June of 2009, she offered Earhart a job on her staff.

When news of this job offer reached the ears of Henry Clark and his wife, the two of them confronted Mary and demanded that she fire Earhart and remove her other daughters from his influence.

News of this interference reached Earhart’s ears on Thursday, July 2. He apparently stewed on it for a day; but Friday night found him in a more pro-active mood.

“Early Friday evening, Earhart began to tank up, and at dusk went down to the hotel conducted by Mrs. Granger,” the Heppner Gazette reporter wrote. “Upon meeting the woman in front of the hotel on the sidewalk, a quarrel ensued. The quarrel, after reaching the warm stage, was taken up by Henry Clark.”

Clark was, of course, just the man Earhart wanted to see, and he pulled a big knife out of his pocket with which to continue the conversation — escalating the imminent conflict from fists to knives. Clark responded by escalating things a bit more — with a revolver. Mary Granger jumped between the two men, trying to hold Clark, who fired over her shoulder at Earhart. Then, shaking free, he ran to the street and fired three more shots after the fast-retreating ex-con. All were clean misses.

But Earhart didn’t scare that easy — not, at any rate, when drunk. Running to Walker’s General Merchandise store, he kicked out the plate-glass front window and

ducked into the building, making for the gun counter. He was looking for a Winchester rifle, with which to continue the arms race with Clark.

Luckily for everyone involved, he couldn’t find the rifles in the dark. But he did find a dandy double-barreled shotgun, and grabbing a couple boxes of shells (loaded, in another stroke of luck for all involved, with No. 1 bird-shot) he headed for the door, bashing the lock off with the butt of the shotgun to let himself out. Then he struck out for Clark’s house.

Nobody was there. But on his way back to town, Earhart met Clark with another man. Leveling the shotgun at them, he ordered them to climb over a nearby fence, and as they did so, he pumped a charge of bird shot into Clark’s back. Luckily for Clark, it didn’t penetrate enough to inflict more than a painful flesh wound and knock him off the fence, where presumably he had the good sense to not move.

Meanwhile, Ione residents who’d seen or heard the burglary at Walker’s store had reported the situation to the town marshal and sheriff’s deputy. Soon virtually every man in Ione was excitedly (and, in most cases, drunkenly; after all, it was Friday night) hurrying home, arming himself, and presenting himself for service on a posse. The officers were gathering and instructing the excited members of the still-growing posse on the main street in town, apparently unaware that their quarry was sitting quietly on the steps of the drugstore next to a friend whom he’d forced at gunpoint to accompany him.

Finally, Earhart looked

over at his friend, remarked that it was his turn to make a move, and started up the street.

The movement caught someone’s eye, and a shout went up from the posse: “Stop right there!” Earhart’s reply was two quick blasts from the shotgun as he took to his heels, heading for the far side of a blacksmith’s shop; the path before him was lighted by the muzzle flashes of at least a dozen posse members’ rifles and pistols, but somehow none of the bullets hit him, although one did graze his back.

As he ran, Earhart tripped over an elderly hobo, who had spread his bedroll out between two houses. The hobo raised his head, trying to see what had happened — and a member of the posse, seeing him there and thinking he was Earhart, shot him, inflicting a severe chest wound.

“As soon as the facts were realized the posse was considerably rattled, and Earhart’s whereabouts were lost track of,” the Gazette reported.

Assuming Earhart was in one of the warehouses, the posse surrounded them. They soon learned their mistake when the shotgun bellowed again from a nearby bush on the hillside behind them, sending a cloud of stinging .160-caliber pellets at a posse member from 80 yards away. The posse member, peppered with shot but not really hurt, fell to the ground and started yelling for help; Morrow County Sheriff’s Deputy Walter Cason went to help him, and himself got a charge of shot in the back and another in the legs.

After that, the posse reformed and waited for daylight, which finally came and revealed Earhart’s hideout.

Tired, sober and suddenly aware of the hopelessness of his situation, Earhart started crying and begging for mercy. He came out and was soon safely arrested and shackled and on his way to Heppner in the care of the sheriff.

Behind him he left the town of Ione peppered with bullet holes — more than 50 of them on the north side of Main Street alone.

On the way to the sheriff’s office, Earhart and Deputy Walter Cason — who, remember, Earhart had hit with two long-range blasts from the shotgun — got into a nasty verbal fight. It ended with Earhart threatening to come back to Ione and kill Cason — a threat that several other people overheard.

Earhart pleaded Not Guilty to all charges, and his trial was a bit of a circus. “In outlining his case to the jury, (Earhart’s attorney) declared that they would prove the shot fired by Earhart ... was fired accidentally as the result of his stumbling as he walked along the sidewalk,” the Gazette’s reporter wrote. “He said further that they would prove that a conspiracy was formed by the armed mob for the purpose of murdering the accused man.”

Not surprisingly, it didn’t work. He drew four and a half years in the state pen.

One imagines the citizens of Ione didn’t much look forward to Earhart’s release date. Of course, he came straight home. But he found the reception awaiting him somewhat warmer than he might have anticipated.

Maybe Earhart intended to settle his score with Cason upon his return to town, and maybe he’d forgotten all about it. But when he arrived, he found Cason waiting for him.

## Reservations now available for 2025 holiday lights at Shore Acres

COOS BAY — From Thanksgiving to New Year’s Eve, the gardens at Shore Acres State Park shimmer with hundreds of thousands of colored lights and seasonal decorations, and now is the time to book reservations for the display, which runs from November 27 to December 31 this year.

Holiday Lights has been a tradition for more than 30 years, and it attracts thousands of visitors each year. Due to its popularity, those who wish to park must purchase timed-entry parking tickets in advance to see the lights.

The tickets are available now online at <http://Bit.ly/2025holidaylights>. The cost is \$10, which is the park’s standard parking fee. The Friends of Shore Acres manages the event.

Parking time slots are available for 4:30 p.m., 5:30 p.m., 6:30 p.m. and 7:30 p.m. daily. Each vehicle needs a ticket to park at the event, which includes entry for everyone inside the car.

Ticket is per vehicle not per person. For example, if you have eight people in one vehicle, you only need one ticket.

The event switched to timed-entry tickets in 2022, and the move has improved safety and the visitor experience.

“The event had become so popular in previous years that vehicles were waiting hours on the road, and traffic was backing up the highway. Vehicles are no longer waiting in long lines on the road to enter the event,” said Park Manager Lee Ricci.

Please note that parking on the road is not allowed, and parking outside Shore Acres in other day-use areas, including parking pullouts, is not permitted after dusk because those areas are closed.

The \$10 fee for parking may be waived (but a reservation is still necessary) if the person making the reservation has one of the following and selects the option during the reservation:

- 12- or 24-month parking permit
- Special access pass for either veterans with service-connected disabilities or foster, guardian and adoptive foster parents of Oregon foster children

Reservations also can be made by calling 800-452-5687. Visitors must have reservations prior to arrival.

Visitors must present a screenshot of the ticket on their smartphone or the printed ticket when entering Holiday Lights, as well as the selected pass, permit or campground confirmation if applicable. Park staff asks that visitors have everything ready to show to keep traffic moving.

Although visitors can reserve their timed entry parking spot now, additional time slots will be available later this fall during a seven-day rolling window. For example: Visitors can make reservations on Nov. 20 for visits on Nov. 27, and so on. The rolling window continues through the end of the event Dec. 31 so visitors are encouraged to keep “We realize that many families are just starting to think about their winter plans, and we want people to still have the chance for spur-of-the-moment visits.” Ricci said. “That is why half the tickets are on the rolling seven-day window to ensure visitors can reserve closer to the event.”

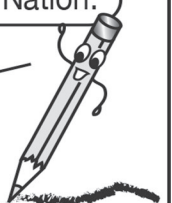

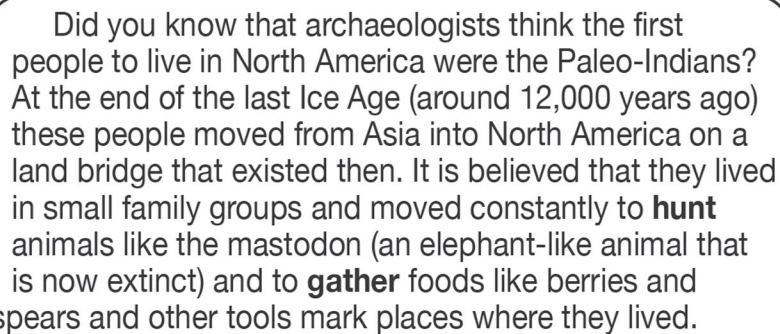

nuts. Arrowheads for spears and other tools mark places where they lived.

In the Archaic period (8,000 to 1,000 BCE), families had homes with wooden poles covered with hides, which could be **moved**. In the spring they would move to the river valleys to **fish** and **collect** shellfish. In the fall they would move to the forest to hunt deer or turkey and gather nuts and berries. Archaeologists have studied **tools**, soapstone bowls, burial grounds and pottery to understand these people's ways.

In a more recent period, Woodland Indians, people are thought to have had villages as well as seasonal camps. **Corn**, a key part of the Indian diet, was introduced. The first evidence for the bow and arrow were found. It is believed that people were **trading**: salt, beads, shells, fish, pottery and animal skins. 🐾

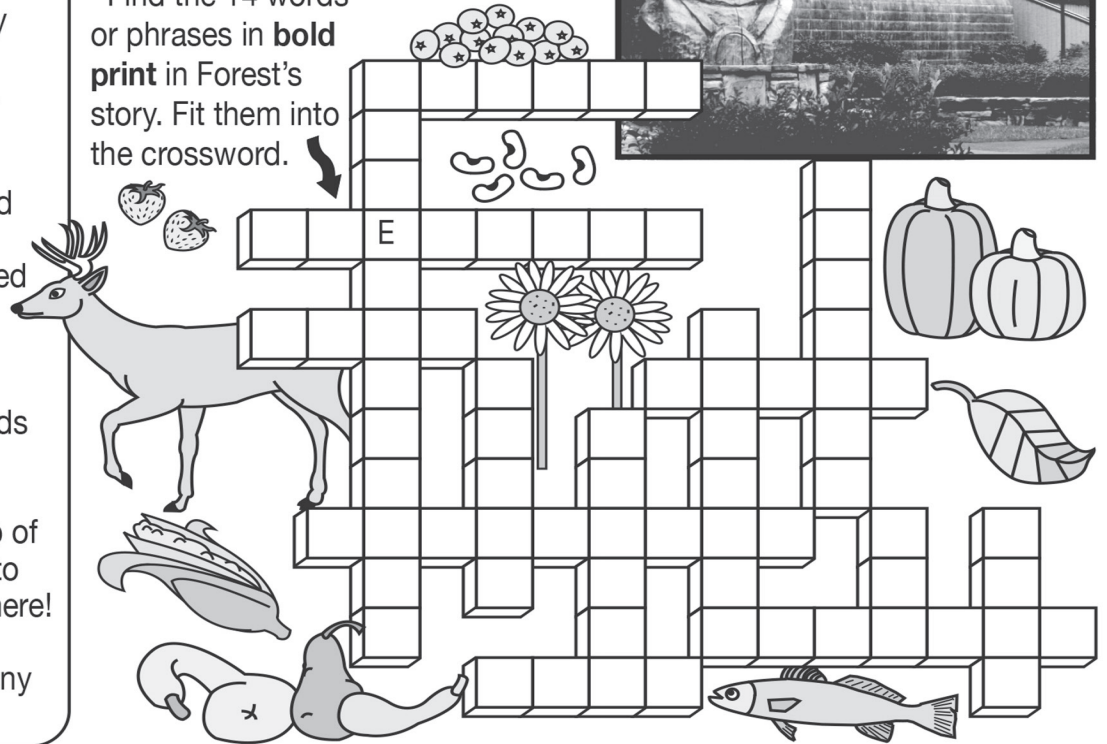
During the next period, Mississippian Indians, settlements became more permanent. Squash, corn and beans, known as the **Three Sisters**, were important and foods from hunting and gathering were now added to the foods harvested from gardens. Beautiful **jewelry** and pottery were created too.

After 1650, when Europeans arrived, there were years of both peace and fighting. In 1836, the U.S. Senate accepted a **treaty** signed by a small group of **Cherokee** to sell their land and the Cherokee were forced to leave the east to be **resettled** in Oklahoma. They were expected to walk 1,000 miles to get there! On this hard walk, now called the "Trail of Tears," an estimated 4,000-8,000 people died. Some Cherokee refused to move and **hid** in the mountains. Many of their descendants now live on Qualla Boundary, a preserve.



About 15,000 Cherokee Indians live in North Carolina, mostly on tribal land. The town of Cherokee is in the Great Smoky Mountains.

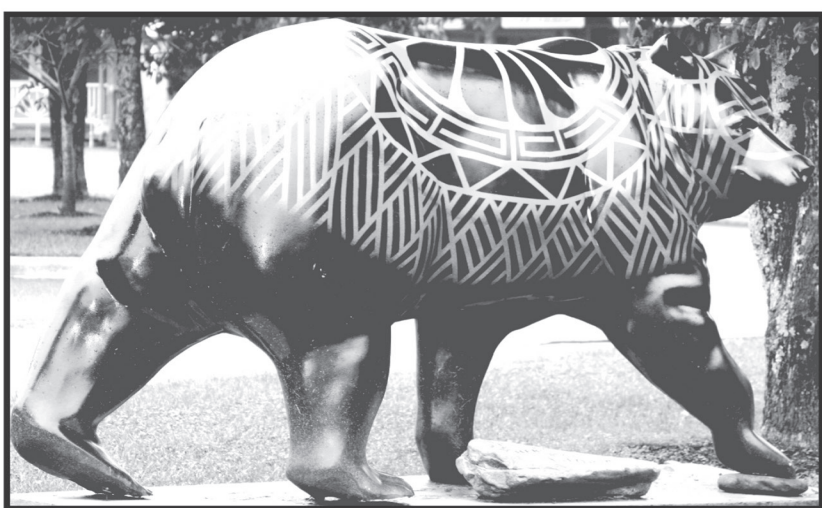
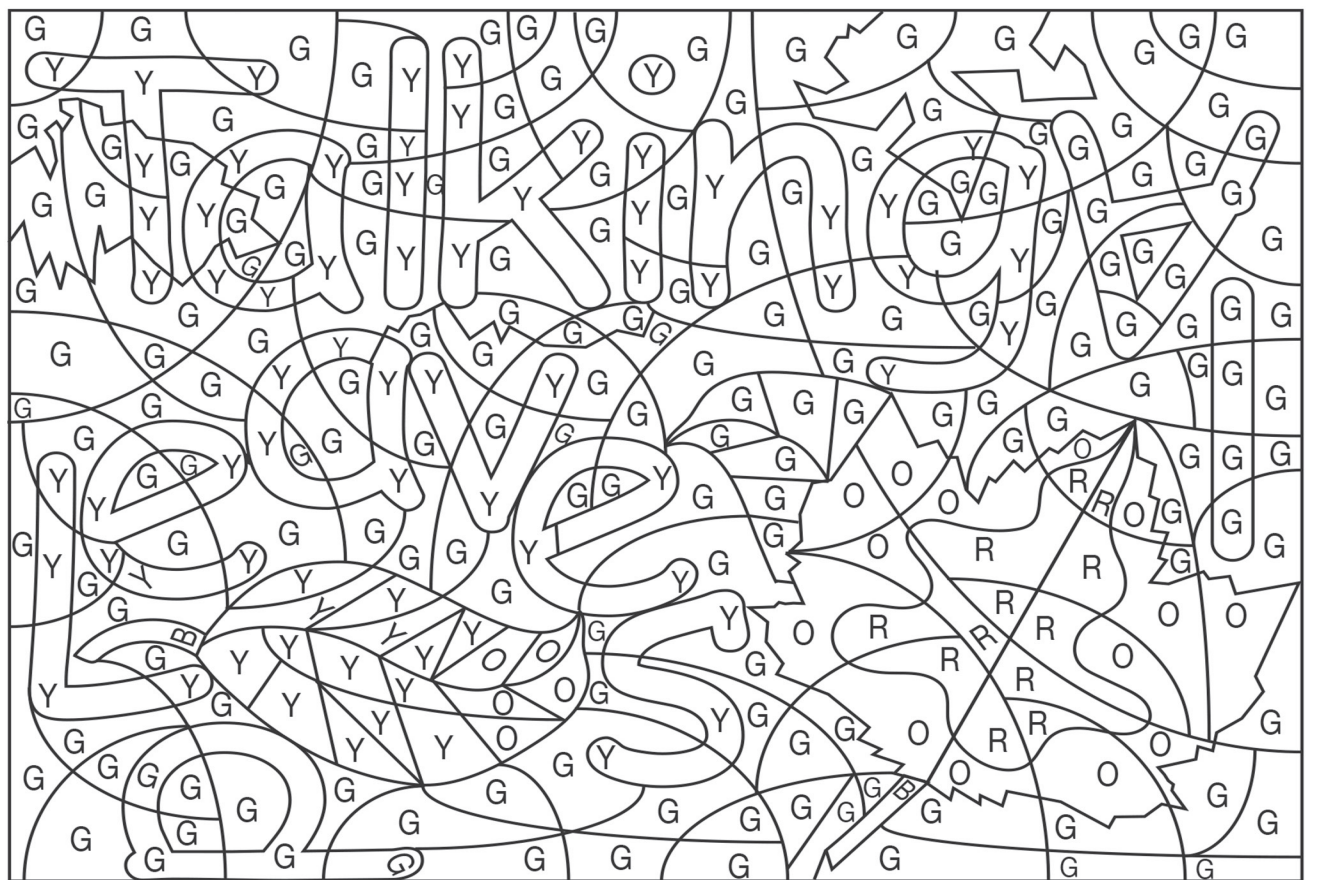
Sequoyah was a young Cherokee who learned how to work with silver.

He wanted to sign his work like the European silversmiths did, so he visited Chief Charles Hicks, who could write in English. After Sequoyah learned to write his name using the alphabet, he began to think about creating a writing system for the Cherokee language. With it, they would be able to read and write letters, write down stories and record their history. He created a system where each sound was represented by a symbol, so each letter was a syllable of a word. His system was easy to use and many Cherokee learned to read and write using it.
