Cow Creek Foundation grants over \$759k to non-profits

ROSEBURG -- The Cow Creek Umpqua Indian Foundation celebrated its winter awards ceremony on Thursday at Seven Feathers Casino Resort, distributing \$759,930 to 93 of Southern Oregon's most dedicated and compassionate non-profit organizations that work tirelessly to strengthen their communities.

The grants were awarded to non-profits in Douglas, Jackson, Josephine, Coos, Klamath, Lane and Deschutes counties. With Thursday's awards, the total amount of philanthropic giving by the Cow Creek Umpqua Indian Foundation (CCUIF) reached \$27,199,988 since it was founded in 1997.

The ceremony brought together dozens of non-profit leaders who confront some of the most pressing challenges facing Southern Oregon communities, from food insecurity and housing instability to youth development and healthcare access.

"Non-profit work is hard. You are understaffed and underfund-

ed. There are bureaucratic hurdles, burnout, and the emotional weight of witnessing suffering in the community. The problems you're trying to solve are getting more complex," said Carla Keene, Chairman of the Cow Creek Band of Umpqua Tribe of Indians. "Yet you show up. You keep going. You find ways to do more with less. Thank you for your resilience."

"I've known many of you for a long time and I think of the foundation now as a woven blanket," said CCUIF Executive Director Carma Mornarich. "The people of Southern Oregon are now covered and warmed by a blanket that you all wove together. I thank you for creating that warm blanket that wraps around our communities."

CCUIF makes contributions twice per year based on the following core principles: no one should go hungry; every child should feel safe; education builds character; and healthy bodies and healthy minds

mean healthy communities.

Grantees apply for specific funds that are dedicated to projects outlined in their application. Some notable recipients of this term's grants include: Furnish Hope, a furniture

bank in Deschutes County that received \$5,000 to provide free furnishings to low-income people and families transitioning from homelessness; Adventure! Children's Museum in Lane County that received

\$7,500 to offset costs for reduced or free entrance for families; Grants Pass Family YMCA in Josephine County who received \$10,000 to help organize day camp field trips for

Access still open but emails needed



Days Creek boys remain perfect in league

DAYS CREEK — The Days Creek boys basketball squad added two more league notches to the proverbial belt this last week as they took down North Douglas and Camas Valley, 71-56 and 77-29, respectfully.

The two victories kept the Wolves Skyline League record unblemished at 4-0.

The first of the two contests came on Friday evening, January 16, as North Douglas visited Days Creek, a place where one longtime coach and fan of south county athletics said James Ellis rarely gets beat, referring to Days Creek Head Coach James Ellis. Ellis has been at the helm of Days Creek basketball for 32 years and amassed a total of 522 wins as a boys basketball coach.

On Friday night Days Creek jumped out to an early 7-0 lead but North Douglas came roaring back and took the first quarter 15-14.

In the second quarter the Wolves turned up the defense just a bit and outscored the Warriors 12-8 to take a slim 26-23 halftime lead.

In the third quarter Days

Creek came out firing and was red hot as they scored the first six points of the quarter and with just three minutes gone in the period North Douglas called a timeout after Days Creek opened up a double digit lead at 39-27, capping a 13-4 run.

Over the remainder of the quarter the two played fairly even and the Wolves took the quarter 25-14 to open up a 51-37 lead as they never looked back.

In the fourth it was more of the same with the Warriors being unable to cut into the Days Creek advantage.

The Wolves pushed the lead out even further as they took the quarter 20-15 for the 18 point victory, 71-52.

Senior Xane Hopkins had a career night as he scored a career-high 26 points while grabbing eight rebounds and adding six assists.

Not to be outdone fellow senior Daniel Brown also posted a career-high with 16 point and he logged a double-double in the process as he ripped down 12 boards.

Cam Stufflebeam dumped in 17 points in the winning ef-

fort and Trenton Ladd added 12 points to round out those in double figures.

On Tuesday evening, January 20, the Wolves took to the road to meet Camas Valley.

It didn't take the Wolves long to sting the Hornets as they outscored the host school 24-5 in the first quarter.

They followed that up with a 31-7 advantage in the second to take a commanding 55-12 lead at the halfway point.

In the third quarter the Wolves eased up a bit but still won the quarter 16-8 to go into the final eight minutes up 71-20.

Camas Valley outscored the Wolves 9-6 in the fourth to bring the final tally to 77-29.

Three players wound up with 14 points each led by sophomore Quinton Halstead who was in double figures for the first time this season.

Also amassing 14 points were Hopkins and Ladd while Stufflebeam checked in with 11 rounding out the double figure scoring.

With the victory Days Creek improved to 4-0 in league and 11-5 overall and ranked No. 4 in the most recent O.S.A.A. 1A polls.

One of those five losses came on Saturday, January 17, as the Wolves fell to 5th ranked North Clackamas Christian 62-44.

In that game the Wolves were led by Stufflebeam with 19 points and Ladd added eight.

Next up for the Wolves is a trip to Eddyville on Saturday, January 24, for a non-league match up with the Eagles who are riding a 12 game winning streak.

Days Creek returns to Skyline play on Tuesday, January 27, as they travel to New Hope Christian to take on the Warriors.

RIDDLE — The Riddle Irish boys basketball team put a halt to their five game losing streak on Saturday, January 17, as they hosted Crow and promptly dispatched the Cougars 70-46.

The Irish jumped out early and never looked back as they took the first quarter 19-8.

In the second it was a little closer as Riddle score 17 while holding Crow to 14 to take a 14 point, 36-22, half-time lead.

In the second half the Irish continued to pour it on winning the third quarter 19-13 to go into the final eight minutes up 55-35.

The fourth quarter proved to be more of the same as once again the Irish prevailed taking the quarter 15-11 and the game 70-46.

Leading the offensive charge for Riddle was Cole Carty who poured in 25 points which included four of Riddle's nine connections from beyond the arc.

Nick McKinney added 12 points and Stephen Nordyke and Rafael Lopez each had seven points.

The victory improved Riddle's record to 9-6 overall.

Riddle returns to Skyline League play on Friday, January 23, as they host league leading Umpqua Valley Christian.

Offbeat Oregon History

For Milwaukie gas station owner, buying bomber was a wild adventure

It was the summer of 1947, and Art Lacey was in serious trouble.

He was about 50 feet above an Oklahoma airfield, at the controls of the biggest airplane he'd ever flown — a four-engined B-17G Flying Fortress, one of hundreds of the heavy bombers that the government was selling as surplus in the wake of the Second World War. This one was his; he had just bought it for \$13,000. But now the landing gear were stuck in

thought it would look to have one of them perched above the gas pumps at his gas station on McLoughlin Boulevard. The wings could serve as a roof over the pumps, and there would be room for a lot of them. And best of all, it wouldn't cost that much more than a stick-built structure of similar size.

According to Art's daughter, Punky Scott, in an interview with KATU-TV Channel 2 News, the scheme he developed remained just a scheme until someone put money on

never flown a four-engine bomber in his life. He was a skilled private pilot of single-engine planes, but this was very different.

Still, Art was determined to have his plane. So he returned the next day with the borrowed mannequin, strapped it into the copilot's seat, breezed into the manager's office and walked out ready to fly home.

Hoping to familiarize himself with the big aircraft a bit before he started flying it for real, he started out with a few passes, touch-and-gos, and

gentle turns — the yoke in one hand and the flight manual in the other. And it was going pretty well, he thought. But then he realized that the landing gear was stuck.

He flew the plane around for a while, trying to figure out how to get it unstuck. Finally he realized he'd just have to bring the plane in on its belly and hope for the best.

So down came Art Lacey in his new, doomed warbird, landing in a shower of sparks with a screech of tearing metal.

Although the cat was now out of the bag, the manager felt bad about the broken landing gear — and probably a little relieved, too, since his customer wasn't dead.

"He turned to his secretary and said, 'Have you written up the bill of sale yet on that B-17?'" Punky recounted. "And she said no, and he said, 'Worst case of wind damage I've ever seen.' And so he sold him a second B-17."

The second plane set Art back just \$1,500 — a special deal the manager made him,

knowing he'd spent all his money on the first one.

Of course, faking the co-pilot was no longer going to work, so Art called his wife long-distance and asked her to send two of his friends down with a case of whiskey. The booze was to be used to bribe the local fire department to pump the fuel out of the old B-17 and into the new one using their fire truck, and it was a powerful enticement; Oklahoma was still a dry state at the time.


A 1960s postcard. The Bomber during its mid-1960s heyday.

the retracted position, and it looked like he was about to crash it.

This wouldn't have been such a big deal if it weren't for his "co-pilot." Art, not wanting to bother with getting someone to tag along with him, had brought a dressmaker's mannequin borrowed from a friend, dressed it in flight gear and propped up in the seat, to fool the airfield manager into thinking there were two guys in the cockpit. After crashing the plane and 'fessing up to this bit of deception, Art knew he would be in a less-than-optimal bargaining position vis-à-vis the defect in the plane he'd bought.

Still, that was all in the future. For now, the number-one goal was to not die in a giant fireball following a botched attempt at a gear-up landing. He lined the plane up as best he could with the runway and prepared to do his best.

Art's whole crazy scheme had its genesis when he first learned about the surplus B-17s. They were super-cheap, selling for not much above their scrap value, because there just weren't very many practical civilian uses for an obsolete heavy bomber. Art, already a successful Milwaukie businessman, had started stewing over how he might take advantage of the low prices on the big warbirds. The more he thought about it, the cooler he





for children during summer break; The Dora Public Library of Coos County who received \$2,930 to create a multi-generational cooking class for local families; Cobb Children's Learning Center in Douglas County who received \$10,000 to close tuition gaps for low-income families in need of childcare; Friends of the Children of Klamath Basin in Klamath County who received \$10,000 to continue

pairing mentors with children who have experienced severe trauma; and \$5,000 to Oregon Lions Sight and Hearing Foundation to support vision screenings at schools in Coos, Deschutes, Douglas, Josephine, Jackson, Klamath, and Lane counties.

Local recipients included Riddle School District which received \$8,000 to provide funding for play equipment and amenities at the Riddle Community Schoolyard and

Riddle Elementary.

Of the 93 grantees awarded funds on Thursday, 47 of them received \$10,000 to advance their community projects. Grant funds are allocated from a percentage of revenue generated from gaming at Seven Feathers Casino Resort and dedicated to charitable giving in the Cow Creek Band of Umpqua Tribe of Indians' seven-county service area.

The mission of the Cow

Creek Umpqua Indian Foundation is to offer assistance in youth education, strengthen youth and family, provide for positive youth development, and add to the quality of life for people in southwestern Oregon.

Increasing emphasis upon basic needs and feeding hungry people has been part of the CUIF mission in recent

years.

In addition to the hundreds of thousands of dollars in foundation awards that are distributed twice per year, the Tribal Board of Directors for the Cow Creek Umpqua Tribal Government also make regular philanthropic donations throughout the community, most recently \$34,000 to Douglas County food pantries

last month, and over \$130,000 to local school districts to feed children and families over the Thanksgiving and Christmas holiday breaks.

Seven Feathers Casino Resort is located in Canyonville within the Cow Creek Umpqua ancestral territory, six miles from where Tribal leaders in 1853 signed a treaty with the U.S. Government.

Roseburg schools, UCC partnering on expanded healthcare career pathways

ROSEBURG — The Roseburg Schools Board of Directors voted January 14 on a \$2.5 million investment in partnership with Umpqua Community College to support the Welcome Center and Medical Careers Hub currently under construction on UCC's campus. The investment reflects a broader community development effort to strengthen Douglas County's economy, improve access to healthcare, and create clear, locally rooted pathways from education to family-wage careers.

The partnership is intended to support learning spaces and programming designed to serve Roseburg High School students pursuing healthcare career pathways. By expanding postsecondary opportunities close to home, the project aligns student success with regional workforce needs and long-term community health outcomes.

Both the UCC and Roseburg Schools Boards of Directors voted at the joint meeting to approve a 25-year agreement and programming commitment between the district and college. The agreement recognizes the common goal to provide Roseburg High School students accelerated access to medical career pathways through instructional space incorporated into the UCC Welcome Center and Medical Careers Hub.

With parts of Douglas County designated as Health Professional Shortage Areas, local leaders say growing the healthcare workforce from within the community is essential to meeting current demand while ensuring sustainable care for the future.

"This is more than a building; it's a shared investment in our region's future," said Dr. Rachel Pokrandt, president of Umpqua Community College. "By working together, we are strengthening the connection between education, workforce preparation and the health of our community."

Roseburg Schools Superintendent Jared Cordon said the investment builds on successful collaboration already underway between the district and college.

"Our students are already completing college-level coursework and earning dual credits while still in high school," Cordon said. "This project allows us to expand that success and open even more doors that lead directly to family-supporting wage careers and postsecondary education, right here in our community."

Regional healthcare leaders emphasized the importance of developing local talent pipelines and improving access to care, particularly for rural and underserved populations. Leaders from Aviva Health, CHI Mercy Health and Umpqua Health shared why this investment matters for the long-term strength of local healthcare.

"Caring for everyone depends on having a strong local healthcare workforce," said KC Bolton, CEO of Aviva Health. "We are helping local students stay local as they train for healthcare ca-

reers, which means more talented Douglas County young people staying here to care for their own and stronger access to care for our community in the years ahead."

"Every day, hospitals across the country feel the impact of staffing shortages in nursing, allied health and support roles," said Russ Woolley, President, CHI Mercy Health - Roseburg. "This unique collaboration between our school district, community college, and Mercy Medical Center helps ensure we

confidently meet growing demand with talent trained right here in our own community. We're excited to support students entering pathways that lead directly to high-impact, deeply meaningful and rewarding careers in healthcare services within our community."

Strong health systems begin with strong people, and this partnership builds both," said Umpqua Health CEO Brent Eichman. "This partnership demonstrates the strong linkage between investments in local education and improved community well-being. We see this as a smart, upstream investment in improving individual and community health."

This joint initiative reflects a growing integration between Roseburg Schools and UCC. Through dual credit offerings primarily available through UCC, Roseburg Schools saved students and families nearly \$900,000 in

tuition last school year and is on track to exceed that amount this year. UCC students already graduate with a student loan debt far below the national average, making this an especially smart and sustainable path for local students.

Career pathway coursework also supports student engagement and success. In 2024, Roseburg High School

students who completed at least two Career and Technical Education courses graduated at a rate of 95 percent.

Pathways in allied health, engineering, trades, forestry, education and other fields are developed in collaboration with industry partners and aligned to national standards.

These pathways continue to evolve as Roseburg Schools,

UCC and regional partners

identify new opportunities to better connect student learning with workforce needs.

"We don't have a talent problem in Douglas County, we have a training opportunity," Cordon said. "This medical center partnership helps ensure our students can become the skilled professionals our local healthcare system and community depend on."

Everything worked as planned, although Art had to kite a check in Palm Springs to refuel the big plane; luckily, he made it home to cover his paper before it could bounce.

But when he got home, Art found his troubles had just begun. The city of Portland wouldn't issue permits to bring the plane from the airport. It was just too big, even after the wings were dismantled.

But Art was in so deep now, there was no turning back. He scheduled the move for the dark of night, well after the bars had all closed. He hired two teenagers with hot cars to accompany the motorcade,

with instructions to floor it and race off recklessly into the night if the police should appear — the idea being to draw the cops away from the plane. The truck drivers were instructed that under no circumstances were they to stop before they arrived at the gas station, no matter who ordered them to. And he promised to pay any tickets anyone was written by any cop for his or her part in the move.

The move's only mishap was a drunk driver who, see-

ing an airplane bearing down on him, thought he'd accidentally driven out onto an airfield and panicked and skidded into the ditch.

City Hall officials were, of course, furious. But after their initial attempts to punish Art resulted in some very unflattering newspaper coverage, they gave it up, fined him \$10, declared victory and went home.

Art was able to pay half his fine with the \$5 collected from his friend. He promptly had his airplane mounted above the gas pumps and renamed the place "The Bomber." And there it sat for the next 63 years, bringing in hundreds of thousands of curious gawkers and customers alike.

Over the years the Lacey's added a restaurant and a small hotel. In the early 1990s they closed the gas pumps, and the big B-17 started to look increasingly forlorn up there, exposed to the weather and the occasional predations of vandals.

Then, in 1996, the family decided to do something about it — and the B-17 Alliance was born, dedicated to restoring the "Lacey Lady," as they've dubbed the bomber.

Currently the bomber is in the B-17 Alliance Museum and Restoration, located at McNary Airfield in Salem (3278 25th St. SE). The museum is open Fridays through Sundays from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. The multi-million-dollar restoration still has a ways to go before it's successfully completed, and the Alliance is working to raise the necessary funds to get it done; when it is, the Lacey Lady will be one of just seven B-17s remaining in flyable condition. Hundreds of municipalities behind on filing required financial reports

Latest memo shows 238 entities with delinquent reports as of December 2025

SALEM — More than 200 municipalities are still delinquent in filing their required financial reports, according to an update from the Secretary of State's Office. These municipalities include all counties, cities, school districts, special districts, and public corporations subject to control by local governments.

"While I'm glad to see some improvement in these numbers, too many municipalities still aren't meeting their deadlines," said Secretary of State Tobias Read. "Oregonians rely on these financial reports to keep their local governments accountable, and they have every right to expect municipalities provide this information promptly."

Oregon's Municipal Audit Program periodically publishes a list of municipalities that haven't filed their required financial reports for the last few fiscal years. The most recent list shows that as of December 2025, there were 238 entities with delinquent reports, many of which were delinquent for multiple years.

A "Yes" vote adopts the amendment to the current Charter for the City of Myrtle Creek and replaces the current Charter language to requiring the City Administrator to live within the 97457 Myrtle Creek zip code.

A "No" vote keeps the current Myrtle Creek City Charter unchanged requiring the City Administrator to live within the Myrtle Creek city limits.

The number of delinquent filers remains significantly higher than when the Audits Division began publishing this information in 2017; however, it is an improvement from May 2025, when 385 municipalities were delinquent.

Under Municipal Audit Law, Oregon's municipalities are required to submit annual reports with key financial information to the Secretary of State's Office. For most entities, this report must be a financial audit conducted by a certified public accountant; for other, smaller entities, they may self-report expenditure information.

In February 2025, the office released a summary report that found a record number of municipalities were falling behind in filing these required reports. Auditors

noted a major reason for the delinquent filings was a lack of adequate resources and persistent issues around staffing, both turnover and filling positions.

There may be consequences for municipalities that are delinquent.

Entities that don't file a report may jeopardize their ability to service debt, obtain

new debt, comply with grant requirements, or obtain new grants. School districts may have state school funds withheld by the Oregon Department of Education. Special

districts may be subject to dissolution if they don't file reports for three consecutive years.

Phone and Internet Discounts Available to CenturyLink Customers

The Oregon Public Utility Commission designated CenturyLink as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier within its service area for universal service purposes. CenturyLink's basic local service rates for residential voice lines are \$27.30 per month, and business services are \$43.50 per month. Specific rates will be provided upon request.

CenturyLink participates in the Lifeline program, which makes residential telephone or qualifying broadband service more affordable to eligible low-income individuals and families. Eligible customers may qualify for Lifeline discounts of \$5.25/month for voice or bundled voice service or \$9.25/month for qualifying broadband or broadband bundles. Residents who live on federally recognized Tribal Lands may qualify for additional Tribal benefits if they participate in certain additional federal eligibility programs. The Lifeline discount is available for only one telephone or qualifying broadband service per household, which can be either a wireline or wireless service. Broadband speeds must be at least 25 Mbps download and 3 Mbps upload to qualify.

A household is defined as any individual or group of individuals who live together at the same address and share income and expenses. Services are not transferable, and only eligible consumers may enroll in these programs. Consumers who willfully make false statements to obtain these discounts can be punished by fine or imprisonment and can be barred from these programs.
